YOU WILL NEED

All types of unwanted paper:

- Newspaper
- Printed paper
- Junk mail etc.



WHAT TO DO

If you have any surplus paper lying around at home, you and your child can have fun shredding it. Shredding paper provides hours of fun for children of all ages. Older children can get involved too, shredding paper with their younger siblings.

Note: Make sure you remove all staples before shredding.

LEARNING & DEVELOPMENT

Children can develop their sense of wonder as they hide in the sea of paper. They can enjoy hide and seek games, peek-a-boo games, and games where they must look for hidden objects. This helps to develop 'object permanence' - knowing something is there without directly looking at it. This is an open-ended resource for the whole family to enjoy.
